Presider Do such who believe Jesus the only Savior, then able to seek their salvation and welfare of saints, of themselves, or anywhere else?

**All-Together They do not; for though they boast of him in words, yet in deeds they deny Jesus the only deliverer and Savior; for one of these two things must be true, that either Jesus is not a complete Savior; or that they, who by a true faith receive this Savior, must find all things in him necessary to their salvation.**
